MOSAICS is a K-12 program for students with significant social/emotional and behavioral challenges that interfere with their ability to progress in their home school district.

MOSAICS provides an intense set of interventions to help a student gain skills and progress while remaining in a public school setting.

MOSAICS is a program of the Hamilton-Boone-Madison Special Services Cooperative.

It is located within the Hamilton Heights High School.

The MOSAICS Program

Activities

MOSAICS staff members will teach the school subjects you find in any public school. There are a variety of opportunities for physical activities and movement.

In addition to these activities, your child will participate in programs designed specifically to improve executive functioning, social skills, and the ability to regulate social, emotional, cognitive, and prosocial skills. If your child receives speech/language or physical/occupational therapy, this will continue while attending MOSAICS.

Length of Stay

Every child and circumstance is different. The goal is to help your child develop the ability to self-regulate emotions, thinking, and social skills so they can return to a more traditional school setting.

How Does MOSAICS Work?

Instead of going to his/her home school, your child will attend classes at MOSAICS. Staff members will work with you and your student to develop a plan to support the development of skills your child needs to self-regulate and maximize learning
